Negative Covid Test or Proof of Vaccination

We encourage all attendees who can to get vaccinated. Either proof of being fully vaccinated or a negative Covid-19 test result taken within 72 hours of the event date must be provided to the Omni staff upon entry to St. Mark's Lutheran Church on the day of the concert.

Mask requirement

All attendees must wear a mask over their nose and mouth while inside St. Mark's Lutheran Church on the day of the concert.

Hall capacity

Based on the live video shoot concert format, concerts at St. Mark's Lutheran Church will be limited to 50 people during the Fall of 2021. This capacity will increase for concerts in the Spring of 2022.
